

Table I. A Census of Homeless People in Dublin 2005

- 1 in 3 have Hepatitis C.
- 1 in 20 have Hepatitis B.
- 1 in 20 have HIV.
- 1 in 35 have a history of TB.
- 3 out of 4 have an alcohol problem
- 1 in 3 have a current drug problem. (versus <1/100 in the general population.)^{li}
- 1 in 2 have depression and 2 out of 5 have anxiety. Dual diagnosis (i.e. co-existing mental health and drug addiction problems) is very common amongst homeless people.
- 1 in 5 have a diagnosis of a schizophrenia.
- Homeless people have high levels of foot conditions and dental problems
